This order was made on 3rd January, 1973 by the Minister under section 24A (1) of the Severance Payments Act.

Commencement: 3rd January, 1973.

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Severance Payments (Management of Fund) (Delegation) Order, 1973.
- 2. The Minister hereby delegates to the National Insurance Board established by section 3 of the National Insurance and Cap. 47. Social Security Act the following functions of the Minister under Part V of the Act
 - (a) the control and management of the Fund conferred on the Minister by section 24 (1) of the Act;
 - (b) the repayment out of the Fund into the Consolidated Fund under subsection (3) of section 27 of the Act of any sums advanced by Parliament pursuant to subsection (2) of that section;
 - (c) the payment of rebates out of the Fund to employers under section 29 (1) of the Act;
 - (d) the power of the Minister to withhold or reduce the amount of rebates under section 29 (6) of the Act:
 - (e) the making of payments out of the Fund to employers under section 30 (1) of the Act:
 - (f) the determination under subsection (3) of section 30 of the Act of the amount which payments made to an employer under that section may not exceed in respect of any period;
 - (g) the determination of applications by employees for 1981/143. payments under subsection (1), the making of such payments under subsection (2), and the enforcement of all rights and remedies conferred on the Minister by subsection (3), of section 31;
 - (h) the power of the Minister under section 32 (1) of the Act to require the provision of information and the production for examination of documents.
