An Act to amend the *Supreme Court of Judicature Act*, Cap. 117A.

[Commencement: 17th July, 2020]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Barbados as follows:

**Short title**

- 1.** This Act may be cited as the *Supreme Court of Judicature (Amendment) Act, 2020*.

**Amendment of section 69A of Cap. 117A**

**2. *Section 69A of the Supreme Court of Judicature Act, Cap. 117A is amended by deleting***

***(a) subsection (1) and substituting the following:***

“(1) Masters of the High Court shall be appointed by the Governor-General on the advice of the Prime Minister after consultation with the Chairman of the Judicial and Legal Service Commission.”; and

***(b) subsection (2) and substituting the following:***

“(2) No person may be appointed as a Master unless that person is an attorney-at-law who has practiced as such for not less than 10 years.”.
