TELECOMMUNICATIONS (CITIZENS' BAND RADIO SERVICE) REGULATIONS, 2004

Authority: These Regulations were made on 16th January, 2004 by the Minister under section 110(1) of the *Telecommunications Act*.

Commencement: 5th February, 2004.

**1.** These Regulations may be cited as the *Telecommunications* (*Citizens' Band Radio Service*) Regulations, 2004.

2. In these Regulations,

"Citizens' Band (CB) radio service" means a private two-way voice communication service with a communication range of one to five miles for use in the personal or business activities of the general public.

**3.** A person who is desirous of providing a Citizens' Band radio service may,

(a) on application to the Minister in the form set out in Part I of the *Schedule*; and

(b) on payment of the relevant fee specified in the *Telecommuni-* 2003/78. *cations (Licence Fees) Regulations,* 2003,

obtain a licence for the purpose.

**5.** Subject to regulation 6, a licence issued under regulation 3 shall expire on the 31st December following the date of issue, and is renewable during the month of January in each year on payment of the relevant fees specified in the *Telecommunications (Licence Fees) Regulations, 2003.* 

**6.** Where the licensee fails to comply with paragraph (*b*) of regulation 4 or any conditions that may be specified in the licence, the Minister may cancel or refuse to renew the licence in accordance with the Act.
