## TELECOMMUNICATIONS (DELEGATION OF POWERS AND DUTIES) ORDER, 2004

2004/165

**Authority:** This Order were made on 30th December, 2004 by the Minister under section 5 of the *Telecommunications Act*.

**Commencement:** 13th January, 2005.

- **1.** This Order may be cited as the *Telecommunications (Delegation of Powers and Duties) Order, 2004.*
- **2.** The Minister hereby delegates the following powers to the Chief Telecommunications Officer:
  - (a) the granting of the following licences:
    - (i) video rental service licences;
    - (ii) dealer's licences;
    - (iii) cyber café licences;
    - (iv) call centre licences;
    - (v) international submarine cable licences;
    - (vi) licences for services where adequate spectrum exists for those services or for services where frequencies have been assigned to those services;
  - (b) the granting of value added domestic voice services; and
  - (c) the granting of all radiocommunications licences except licences relating to trunking and data communications;
  - (d) the power to deal with all matters involving spectrum management under Part IX of the Act;

- (e) the power to deal with all matters pertaining to numbering under Part X of the Act; and
- (f) the power to prescribe certification standards and to establish an equipment certification programme under Part XI of the Act.
