Tourism Development Act
CAP. 341

TOURISM DEVELOPMENT ORDER, 2013

The Minister, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 37 of the *Tourism Development Act*, makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the *Tourism Development Order, 2013*.
2. The *Tourism Development Act*, Cap. 341, is amended by deleting the Second Schedule thereto and substituting the Second Schedule as set out in the *Schedule* to this Order.
3. A person who is licensed to practise medicine in Barbados may, in respect of the provision of services for the transplantation of embryos and other ancillary procedures, import, free of duty, the items set out in Part VI of section B of the Second Schedule.
