1982/114.

Authority: These regulations were made on 29th June, 1982 by the Minister under section 41 of the *Trade Unions Act*.

Commencement: 1st July, 1982.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Trade Unions (Fees) Regulations, 1982*.
