TRAFFIC CONTROL (BRIDGETOWN MARKET) RULES, 2013

The Commissioner of Police, in exercise of the power conferred on him by section 23(2) of the *Police Act*, with the approval of the Minister, makes the following Rules:

1. These Rules may be cited as the *Traffic Control (Bridgetown Market) Rules, 2013*.

2. In these Rules,

“alternate route” means an alternate emergency route that commences at Exmouth Gap and proceeds along Westbury Road, President Kennedy Drive, Fontabelle, Cheapside, Broad Street, Charles Duncan O’Neal Bridge, Fairchild Street, River Road, Martindale’s Road to the Queen Elizabeth Hospital, in the parish of Saint Michael;

“emergency route” means an emergency route that commences at Spring Garden Highway and proceeds along Exmouth Gap, Westbury Road, Passage Road, Country Road, Roebuck Street, Halls Road, Martindale’s Road to the Queen Elizabeth Hospital, in the parish of Saint Michael;

“emergency vehicle” means a vehicle used by

- (a) the Barbados Red Cross;
- (b) the Emergency Management Department; or
- (c) an ambulance service;

“Festival Committee” means the Crop Over Festival Committee of the Ministry responsible for Culture, Sports and Youth;

“relevant period” means the period from 08:00 hours to 23:59 hours on Saturday, 3rd August, 2013 and Sunday, 4th August, 2013;

“vehicle” has the meaning assigned to it by section 2 of the *Road Traffic Act*, Cap. 295.

3. During the relevant period, the Spring Garden Highway from its junction with Holborn Circle to its junction with Brighton Road in the parish Saint Michael shall be closed to all vehicular traffic, except those vehicles used by members of the Festival Committee.

4. During the relevant period, no person shall park or allow a vehicle to remain stationary on the following roads, except for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers:

- (a) Brighton Road from its junction with Black Road Main Road, to its junction with Spring Garden Highway;
- (b) Black Rock Main Road from its junction with University Drive to its junction with Eagle Hall;
- (c) Deacons Farm Road from its junction with Deacons Road to its junction with Brighton Road;
- (d) Deacons Road; and
- (e) Westbury Road,

in the parish of Saint Michael.

5. On the relevant date, during the relevant period, no person shall park or allow a vehicle to remain stationary along the alternate route or the emergency route, except for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers.

6. All drivers and riders of vehicles, pedestrians and riders or leaders of animals using any of the roads specified in paragraphs 3 and 4 or any of the routes specified in paragraph 5 shall exercise caution and shall comply with any other order given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform.

7. Any person who contravenes these Rules or fails to comply with any order given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500 or to imprisonment for a term of 3 months.

8. These Rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Barbados Defence Force, the Barbados Fire Service or any emergency vehicle.
