TRAFFIC CONTROL (COHOBBLOPOT)
RULES, 2009

The Commissioner, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 23(2) of the *Police Act*, with the approval of the Minister, makes the following Rules:

1. These Rules may be cited as the *Traffic Control (Cohobblopot) Rules, 2009*.

2. In these Rules,

“emergency vehicle” means a vehicle used by

- (a) the Barbados Red Cross;
- (b) the Emergency Management Department; or
- (c) an ambulance service;

“Festival Committee” means the Crop Over Festival Committee of the Ministry responsible for Community Development and Culture;

"relevant period" means from 16:00 hours on Sunday, 2nd August, to 02:30 hours on Monday, 3rd August, 2009;

“vehicle” has the meaning assigned to it by section 2 of the *Road Traffic Act* Cap. 295.

3. During the relevant period, Kensington New Road to its junction with Fontabelle Road to its junction with Holborn Circle in the parish of Saint Michael shall be closed to all vehicular traffic except vehicles used by members of the Festival Committee.

4. During the relevant period, President Kennedy Drive from its junction with Westbury Road to its junction with Holborn Circle, in the parish of Saint Michael, shall be closed to all vehicular traffic except vehicles used by members of the Festival Committee.

5. During the relevant period, no parking shall be allowed along Princess Alice Highway from its junction with Cowell Street to its junction with Harbour Road in the parish of Saint Michael.

6. During the relevant period, no driver or person in charge of a vehicle shall park or allow the vehicle to remain stationary on any of the following roads or the adjoining footpaths except for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers:

- (a) Fontabelle Road from its junction with Lakes Folly to its junction with President Kennedy Drive;
- (b) Westbury Road from its junction with President Kennedy Drive to its junction with Baxters Road;
- (c) Princess Kennedy Drive;
- (d) Redman Drive;
- (e) Prescod Boulevard;
- (f) Baxters Road;
- (g) Eagle Hall Road; and
- (h) Spring Garden Highway,

in the parish of Saint Michael.

7. During the relevant period, Fontabelle Road shall be a one-way street from its junction with Redman Drive to its junction with Holborn Circle, in the parish of Saint Michael and traffic shall flow in two lanes towards Holborn Circle.

8. All drivers and riders of vehicles, pedestrians and riders or leaders of animals using any of the roads specified in paragraphs 4, 6 and 7 shall exercise caution and shall comply with any order given by a member of the Police Force in uniform.

9. Any person who contravenes these Rules or fails to comply with any order given by a member of the Police Force in uniform is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500. or to imprisonment for a term of 3 months.

10. These Rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Police Force, the Barbados Defence Force or to any emergency vehicle.
