**TRAFFIC CONTROL (GRAND KADOOMENT) RULES, 2013**

The Commissioner of Police, in exercise of the power conferred on him by section 23(2) of the *Police Act*, with the approval of the Minister, makes the following Rules:

1. These Rules may be cited as the *Traffic Control (Grand Kadooment) Rules, 2013*.

2. In these Rules,

“alternate route” means an alternate emergency route which commences at Lodge Hill and proceeds along Cave Hill, Well Gap, St. Stephen’s Hill, Grazettes, Fairfield Road, Deacons, Westbury Road, Passage Road, Country Road, Roebuck Street, Halls Road, Martindale’s Road to the Queen Elizabeth Hospital, in the parish of Saint Michael;

“band” means any group of persons organised as a costume band by the Festival Committee and approved by the Minister responsible for Culture, Sports and Youth to participate in the Grand Kadooment Parade;

“emergency route” means an emergency route that commences at Warrens and proceeds along Everton Weekes Roundabout, Clyde Walcott Roundabout, Norman Niles Roundabout, My Lord’s Hill Road, Welches Road, Belmont Road, Martindale’s Road to the Queen Elizabeth Hospital in the parish of Saint Michael;

“emergency vehicle” means a vehicle used by

(a) the Barbados Red Cross;

(b) the Department of Emergency Management; or

(c) an ambulance service;

“Festival Committee” means the Crop Over Festival Committee of the Ministry responsible for Culture, Sports and Youth;

“relevant date” means Monday, 5<sup>th</sup> August, 2013;

“route” means a route that commences at Warrens and proceeds along Green Hill Road, Codrington Road, Waterford Road, Station Hill Road, Bank Hall Cross Road, Bank Hall Road, Eagle Hall, Black Rock Main Road, Brighton Road and the Spring Garden Highway in the parish of Saint Michael;

“vehicle” has the meaning assigned to it by section 2 of the *Road Traffic Act*, Cap. 295.

3. On the relevant date, between 07:00 hours and 18:00 hours, bands may parade only along the route, commencing at Warrens and proceeding along the route to the Spring Garden Highway.

4. On the relevant date, between 07:00 hours and 18:00 hours, Codrington Road from its junction with Waterford Road to its junction with Waterford Bottom Road, in the parish of Saint Michael, shall be closed to all vehicular traffic except vehicles used by members of the Festival Committee.

5. On the relevant date, between 07:00 hours and 18:00 hours, the following roads shall be closed to all vehicular traffic, except in respect of vehicles used in the Kadooment Day Parade and vehicles used by members of the Festival Committee:

(a) Bank Hall Cross Road;

(b) Bank Hall Main Road;

(c) Black Rock Road;

(d) Brighton Road;

- (e) Eagle Hall;
- (f) Fontabelle Road;
- (g) Green Hill Road;
- (h) Holborn Circle;
- (i) Prescod Boulevard;
- (j) Princess Alice Highway;
- (k) Redman Road;
- (l) Spring Garden Highway;
- (m) Station Hill Road; and
- (n) Warrens Road,

in the parish of Saint Michael.

6. On the relevant date, between 06:00 hours and 22:00 hours, Spring Garden Highway from its junction with Holborn Circle to its junction with Black Rock Road in the parish of Saint Michael shall be closed to all vehicular traffic except vehicles used in the Kadooment Day Parade and vehicles used by members of the Festival Committee.

7. On the relevant date, between 06:00 hours and 20:00 hours, no person shall drive along, park or allow a vehicle to remain stationary on the route.

8. On the relevant date, between 06:00 hours and 18:00 hours, no person shall drive along, park or allow a vehicle to remain stationary along Stadium Road in the parish of Saint Michael, except for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers.

9. On the relevant date, between 06:00 hours and 22:00 hours, no person shall drive along, park or allow a vehicle to remain stationary on Brighton Road from its junction with Black Rock Main Road to its junction with Spring Garden

Highway in the parish of Saint Michael, except for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers.

**10.** On the relevant date, between 06:00 hours and 22:00 hours, no person shall park or allow a vehicle to remain stationary along the alternate route or the emergency route except for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers.

**11.** All drivers and riders of vehicles, pedestrians and riders or leaders of animals using any of the roads specified in paragraphs 4, 5, 6, 8 and 9 and the routes specified in paragraph 10 shall exercise caution and shall comply with any other order given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform.

**12.** Any person who contravenes these Rules or fails to comply with any order given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500 or to imprisonment for a term of 3 months.

**13.** These Rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Barbados Defence Force, the Barbados Fire Service or an emergency vehicle.
