TRAFFIC CONTROL (GRAND KADOOMENT) RULES, 2019

The Commissioner of Police, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 23(2) of the *Police Act*, with the approval of the Minister, makes the following Rules:

1. These Rules may be cited as the *Traffic Control (Grand Kadooment) Rules, 2019*.

2. In these Rules,

“alternate emergency route” means an alternate route which commences at the National Stadium and proceeds along Butler’s Avenue, Spooners Hill Road, Green Hill Road, Everton Weekes Roundabout, Clyde Walcott Roundabout, Norman Niles Roundabout, My Lord’s Hill Road, Welches Road, Belmont Road and Martindale’s Road to the Queen Elizabeth Hospital, in the parish of Saint Michael;

“band” means a group of persons organized as a costumed band by the Festival Committee and approved by the Minister responsible for Creative Economy, Culture and Sport to participate in the Grand Kadooment Parade;

“emergency route” means a route which commences at the National Stadium and proceeds along Bank Hall Road, Country Road, Roebuck Street, Halls Road and Martindale’s Road to the Queen Elizabeth Hospital, in the parish of Saint Michael;

“emergency vehicle” means a vehicle used by

(a) the Barbados Red Cross;

(b) the Department of Emergency Management; or

(c) an ambulance service;

“Festival Committee” means the Crop Over Festival Committee of the Ministry responsible for Creative Economy, Culture and Sports;

“relevant date” means Monday, 5th August, 2019;

“relevant period” means from 06:00 hours to 20:00 hours;

“route” means a route that commences at Warrens and proceeds along Green Hill Road, Codrington Road, Waterford Road, Station Hill Road, Bank Hall Cross Road, Bank Hall Road, Eagle Hall Road, Black Rock Main Road, Frank Worrell Roundabout and the Mighty Grynner Highway, in the parish of Saint Michael; and

“vehicle” has the meaning assigned to it by section 2 of the *Road Traffic Act*, Cap. 295.

3. On the relevant date, during the relevant period, bands shall parade only along the route commencing at Warrens and proceeding along the route to the Mighty Grynner Highway.

4. On the relevant date, during the relevant period, Codrington Road, from its junction with Waterford Road to its junction with Spooners Hill Road, in the parish of Saint Michael, shall be closed to all vehicular traffic except vehicles used by members of the Festival Committee.

5. On the relevant date, during the relevant period, the following roads shall be closed to all vehicular traffic, except in respect of vehicles used in the Grand Kadooment Day Parade and vehicles used by members of the Festival Committee:

(a) Station Hill Road;

(b) Bank Hall Cross Road;

(c) Bank Hall Main Road;

- (d) Eagle Hall Road;
- (e) Black Rock Road;
- (f) Holborn Circle;
- (g) Prescod Boulevard; and
- (h) the Mighty Grynner Highway,

in the parish of Saint Michael.

6. On the relevant date, between 06:00 hours and 22:00 hours, the Mighty Grynner Highway, from its junction with Holborn Circle to its junction with Frank Walcott Roundabout and Black Rock Road, in the parish of Saint Michael, shall be closed to all vehicular traffic except vehicles used in the Grand Kadooment Day Parade and vehicles used by members of the Festival Committee.

7. On the relevant date, during the relevant period, no person shall drive along, park or allow a vehicle to remain stationary on the route.

8. On the relevant date, during the relevant period, no person shall drive along, park or allow a vehicle to remain stationary along Stadium Road in the parish of Saint Michael, except for the purpose of picking up or setting down passengers.

9. On the relevant date, during the relevant period, no person shall park or allow a vehicle to remain stationary along the emergency route or the alternate emergency route except for the purpose of picking up and setting down passengers.

10. All drivers and riders of vehicles, pedestrians and riders or leaders of animals using any of the roads specified in paragraphs 4, 5, 6 and 8 and the routes specified in paragraph 9 shall exercise caution and shall comply with any other order given by a member of the Police Force in uniform.

11. Any person who contravenes these Rules or fails to comply with any order given by a member of the Police Force in uniform is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500 or to imprisonment for the term of 3 months or to both.

12. These Rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Police Force, the Barbados Defence Force, the Barbados Fire Service, or any emergency vehicle.
