TRAFFIC CONTROL (OISTINS FISH FESTIVAL) RULES, 2017

The Commissioner, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 23(2) of the *Police Act*, with the approval of the Minister, makes the following Rules:

1. These Rules may be cited as the *Traffic Control (Oistins Fish Festival) Rules, 2017*.

2. In these Rules,

“emergency vehicle” means a vehicle used by

- (a) the Barbados Red Cross;
- (b) the Department of Emergency Management; or
- (c) an ambulance service;

“relevant dates” means Saturday, 15th April, 2017 and Monday, 17th April, 2017;

“relevant period” means from 15:00 hours to 00:00 hours;

“vehicle” has the meaning assigned to it by section 2 of the *Road Traffic Act*, Cap. 295.

3. On the relevant dates, the Oistins Fish Festival will take place at Oistins in the parish of Christ Church.

4. On the relevant dates, during the relevant period, Oistins Road from its junction with Keizer Hill Road to its junction with Welches Road in the parish of Christ Church shall be closed to all vehicular traffic.
5. On the relevant dates, during the relevant period, Oistins Road from its junction with Oistins Hill Road in the parish of Christ Church shall be closed to all vehicular traffic.
6. On the relevant dates, during the relevant period, Oistins Road from its junction with Keizer Hill Road in the parish of Christ Church shall be closed to all vehicular traffic.
7. On the relevant dates, during the relevant period, Oistins Road from its junction with Pegwell Road in the parish of Christ Church shall be closed to all vehicular traffic.
8. On the relevant dates, during the relevant period, Cane Vale Hill Road to its junction with Maxwell Hill Road in the parish of Christ Church shall be a one-way street, with traffic travelling in the direction of Maxwell Hill Road.
9. On the relevant dates, during the relevant period, no person shall park a vehicle along:
 - (a) Thornbury Hill Road;
 - (b) Pegwell Road;
 - (c) Keizer Hill Road;
 - (d) Oistins Road;
 - (e) Oistins Hill Road;
 - (f) Welches Road;
 - (g) Cane Vale Hill Road; or
 - (h) Church Hill Road,

in the parish of Christ Church.

10. All drivers and riders of vehicles, pedestrians and riders or leaders of animals using any of the roads specified in these Rules shall exercise caution and shall comply with any order given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform.

11. Any person who contravenes these Rules or fails to comply with any order given by a member of the Royal Barbados Police Force in uniform is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500 or to imprisonment for a term of 3 months.

12. These Rules do not apply to vehicles used by the Royal Barbados Police Force, the Barbados Defence Force, the Barbados Fire Service or any emergency vehicle.
