**TRAFFIC CONTROL (STATE FUNERAL OF THE LATE
HONOURABLE DAVID JOHN HOWARD THOMPSON,
Q.C., M.P., PRIME MINISTER OF BARBADOS)
RULES, 2010**

The Commissioner, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 23(2) of the Police Act, with the approval of the Minister makes the following Rules:

1. These Rules may be cited as the *Traffic Control (State Funeral of the Late Honourable David John Howard Thompson, Q.C., M.P., Prime Minister of Barbados) Rules, 2010*.

2. In these Rules,

“emergency vehicle” means a vehicle used by

- (a) the Barbados Red Cross;
- (b) the Department of Emergency Management; or
- (c) an ambulance service;

“relevant date” means Wednesday 3rd November, 2010;

“relevant period” means from 07:00 hours to 12:00 hours;

“vehicle” has the meaning assigned to it by section 2 of the *Road Traffic Act, Cap. 295*.

3. On the relevant date between 10:00 hours and 11:30 hours, the State Funeral of the late Honourable David John Howard Thompson, Q.C., M.P., Prime Minister of Barbados, will be held at the Kensington Oval.

4. On the relevant date, during the relevant period Eagle Hall Road from its junction with Bridge Gap to its junction with President Kennedy Drive in the parish of Saint Michael shall be closed to all vehicular traffic.

5. On the relevant date, during the relevant period Barbarees Hill from its junction with President Kennedy Drive to its junction with Westbury Road in the parish of Saint Michael shall be closed to all vehicular traffic.

6. On the relevant date, during the relevant period Westbury Road from its junction with Baxters Road to its junction with President Kennedy Drive in the parish of Saint Michael shall be closed to all vehicular traffic.

7. On the relevant date, during the relevant period President Kennedy Drive from its junction with Westbury Road to its junction with Fontabelle Road in the parish of Saint Michael shall be closed to all vehicular traffic.

8. On the relevant date, during the relevant period Fontabelle Road from its junction with President Kennedy Drive to its junction with Lakes Folly in the parish of Saint Michael shall be a one-way street with all vehicular traffic flowing towards Bridgetown in the parish of Saint Michael.

9. On the relevant date, during the relevant period no person shall park along:

- (a) Black Rock Main Road;
- (b) Eagle Hall Road;
- (c) Barbarees Hill;
- (d) President Kennedy Drive;
- (e) Fontabelle Road;

- (f) Samuel Jackman Prescod Boulevard;
- (g) Spring Garden Highway;
- (h) University Row;
- (i) Westbury Road; and
- (j) Westbury New Road,

in the parish of Saint Michael.

10. All drivers and riders of vehicles, pedestrians and riders or leaders of animals using any of the roads specified in these Rules shall exercise caution and shall comply with any order given by a member of the Police Force in uniform.

11. Any person who contravenes these rules or fails to comply with any order given by a member of the Police Force in uniform is guilty of an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine of \$500 or to imprisonment for a term of 3 months.

12. These Rules do not apply to vehicles used by

- (a) the Police Force;
- (b) the Barbados Defence Force;
- (c) the Barbados Fire Service; or
- (d) an emergency vehicle.
